Cimber Sterling signs for CRJ training at OAA Copenhagen

We are pleased to announce that Cimber Sterling, Denmark, has chosen Oxford Aviation Academy as its training partner for CRJ type rating training.

Cimber Sterling A/S have been training their B737NG pilots and cabin crew at OAA Copenhagen for a number of years and have now expanded the current training agreement to also include CRJ flight and cabin crew training.

By the end of February 2010, a CRJ-900 Full Flight Simulator (FFS) will be in operation at our Copenhagen training centre, with a CRJ-200 conversion capability and Head Up Guidance System simulation added by September 2010. In addition to the CRJ-200/900 FFS, OAA will also be able to deliver CRJ pilot type-rating and cabin crew initial training courses.

Cimber Sterling operates low cost services linking eight Scandinavian cities and scheduled services to over 30 destinations in major European cities and holiday destinations. The fleet consists of 20 aircraft, including Bombardier CRJ, B737NG and ATR.
